(ATTENTION: From this day on, Sunday Liturgies will begin at 9:30 am.)

After the Liturgy there will be a Moleben for the beginning of the school year.

Fri. Sept. 7 pm Vespers and Matins.

Sat. Sept. 8 9 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **Vladimir Icon of the Theotokos**;

Martyrs Adrian and Natalia.

On this date we venerate our Vladimir Icon of the Theotokos that has miraculously renewed itself.

Sat. Sept. 8 5 pm All-night Vigil.

Sun. Sept. 9 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. 15th Sunday after Pentecost:

Hieromartyr Kuksha and St. Pimen the Faster of the Kiev-

Caves Lavra.

We have portions of the relics of Sts. Kuksha and Pimen among the relics of the Kiev-Caves Saints.

Note: On Tuesday, September 11 the Church commemorates the Beheading of St. John the Baptist. This is a fast day – wine and oil are allowed, but not meat, dairy products, or fish.
